**Chess**

Chess is fun! Daily activities include in-class tournaments, a friendly staff of experts and a GIANT CHESS BOARD. Beginners to advanced learn and improve their skills

**Clay**

Have fun with clay. Learn about using clay through various media and techniques  
Create fun and exciting projects.

**Dance Connection**

Basic hip hop instruction with introductory movements for the beginning hip hop dancer  
Music is age-appropriate with positive lyrics in a rhythmic atmosphere

**EPGY**

An on-line computer based learning system, math and language arts, allows students to learn or review at own pace and tracks progress

All-in-one after school activity. Extend Kinders day and open to 1-3rd graders. Learn and have fun with writing, reading, history, science, math and games and physical play.

**Hoops**

Learn to play basketball using drills and playing games - dribble, pass, shoot, score!

**Hearts and Crafts**

Through fun, hands-on activities students will be introduced to Community Service Learning and help charities such as local animal shelter, a senior center, troops, veterans and even our own school

**Junior Byte**

Topics range from movie making, programming, robotics, photography and web design with technology focus geared for 4th and 5th graders.

**Junior Museum Science**

Building Bonanza, Science Sampler, Locomotion, Rumble and Roar - 4 week sessions taught by Junior Museum and Science staff

**Living Spanish**

Learn Spanish with games and activities as children learn the language in a proper and meaningful context. Emphasis on listening, speaking and correct pronunciation.

**Learn to Draw**

Develop basic drawing skills while learning techniques and observational skills through proportion, perspective and contrast. Primarily sketchbook based with various media

**Living Mandarin**

Children learn Mandarin through fun and interactive activities such as games, arts and crafts, songs, etc... Emphasis on listening, speaking and correct pronunciation.
