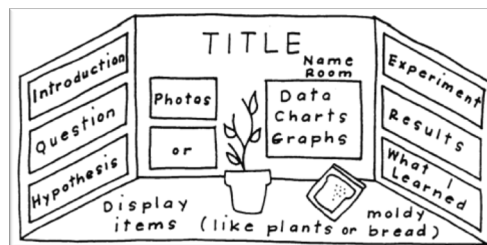
Need Help Getting Started?
